#### Wine description

The premier cru of Vaillons lies to the south west of the town of Chablis on the left bank of the Serein river. It is one of the largest and most significant of the Chablis Premier Crus.

### **Tasting note**

It is an excellent example of the characteristics of a Chablis wine: freshness, acidity, minerality and notes of flowers and fruit. Well-rounded and charming, this wine has a final note of minerality on the palate and is a good compromise between the acidity and fruit. It is generous and has a good length.
