The Premier Cru Vaillons is one of 40 Premier Cru sites in Chablis. It lies on the left bank of the Serein river on Kimmeridgian limestone soils and is close to the Premier Cru Montmains. Vaillons is one of the largest and most well known of the Chablis Premier Cru.

Tasting note

This wine has inviting aromas of flint, peach and citrus. The palate is dry with richly textured mouth feel, with citrus, white peach and floral notes. The finish is intense and long with a lingering minerality.
