Wine description

Established in 1781 in the Northern Rhone Valley, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. The appellation area is located on the left bank of the Rhône, and extends around Tain-l'Hermitage. The Crozes-Hermitage vineyard in Vidal-Fleury extends to the south of the appellation. Here, Syrah is queen.

Tasting note

A nose of blackcurrant, plum, violet but also pepper and grilled, with a vegetal note. A supple, fresh mouth, black fruits, mineral, with roundness and persistence based on fresh fruit.
