Wine description

Established in 1781 Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. The Crozes Hermitage appellation is located in the northern Rhone Valley on gentle slopes and its wines are typically dominated by the Marsanne grape. Vidal-Fleury have made white Crozes Hermitage since the 1980s.

Tasting note

Pale yellow with green highlights. A modern styled wine with floral, white melon, pear, white prune, mineral, hazelnut aromas. The palate is medium bodies and fresh with salty hints and fruit flavours that echo its aromas.
