### Wine description

Established in 1781 Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. The Saint Joseph appellation is located in the Northern Rhone Valley on southern exposed granite slopes, Vidal-Fleury's Saint Joseph comes from the southern sector of the appellation.

### Tasting note

This wine has rich blackcurrant, plum, nutmeg and black pepper aromas. The palate is structured and elegant, with soft dark berry fruit flavours and a touch of earth and spice. It has a concentrated long finish.
