Wine description

Established in 1781 Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. The Saint Joseph appellation is located in the Northern Rhone Valley on southern exposed granite slopes, Vidal-Fleury's Saint Joseph comes from the southern sector of the appellation.

Tasting note

Aromas of black fruits such as blackberry and blackcurrant dominate with notes of pepper, nutmeg and cloves. These flavours continue through the palate complimented by black plum flavours, acidity and silky tannins. The finish is long with spices and woody notes.
