Established in 1781 in the Northern Rhone Valley, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. Today Vidal-Fleury vinify and age wines from accross the Rhône Valley, focusing on the choicest terroirs, allowing ample time to age and mature the wines.

Tasting note

This wine is bright dark red with some black highlights. Blackberry, guarrigue, rosemary and some violet aromas. On the palate silky tannins with some lightly gripping in the finish. Black fruits and spicy notes.
