Wine description

The grapes from this Tiny Trials Cinsault come from two 30-year-old vineyards, located in the Guarilhue area of the Itata Valley, just 20km from the Pacific Ocean. Thanks to this closeness to the sea, there's a strong coastal influence that translates into a slow ripening for the grapes.

Tasting note

A perfumed nose with fresh aromas of strawberry and cherry, accompanied by an elegant note of pink peppercorn and a touch of floral notes. On the palate, it's fresh and lively with smooth tannins and concentrated ripe strawberries and cherries. The finish is long, elegant, with a saline–mineral sensation.
