Wine description

The ViBo Punta del Viento 2012 is a blend of Mediterranean varieties that have adapted very well to the climate and soils in Colchagua. 100% of the grapes come from the El Olivar Vineyard located near the town of Peralillo and the blend is based on Grenache (76%), Mourvèdre (15%) and Syrah (9%).

Tasting note

This wine is intense ruby red in colour. The nose is elegant, complex, and fruity with aromas of red fruits, sweet spices, black currants, and blond tobacco. The lush palate presents good structure and is very rich in acidity and balance with tannins that lend personality and lead to a long, deep, and pleasing finish.
