#### Wine description

The Reserva Sauvignon Blanc was grown on Viu Manent's San Carlos vineyard near Cunaco in the Colchagua Valley. A longer, more gradual growing season than normal has resulted in particularly intense and aromatic wines with lively natural acidity.

#### Tasting note

This wine is a clean, bright, pale, almost transparent yellow color with green highlights. The nose features standout citrus and exotic fruit aromas such as pineapple. The palate is intense and fruity, with moderate volume, fresh acidity, and a pleasing finish.
