Wine description

The Secret de Viu Manent wines are made in a modern style and make the most of the primary fruit characteristics of each grape variety. The grapes for this wine come from two vineyards located in different sectors of the cool Casablanca Valley. One is located beside the town of Casablanca and the other is in Las Dichas, approximately 11 km from the sea.

Tasting note

The nose reveals aromas of white fruits, accompanied by an elegant mineral note and touches of green chili. In the mouth it is fresh with a lovely minerality due to its proximity to the sea. A balanced and full-bodied wine giving way to a persistent and pleasant finish.
