Wine description

Secret Syrah comes from Viu Manent's El Olivar vineyard close to the town of Peralillo in the Colchagua Valley, a relatively new viticultural area that is well suited to the Syrah grape. The wines are fresh and expressive of their place of origin and have good concentration, deep colour, and good typicity.

Tasting note

The expressive nose is fruit-forward, with aromas of black fruit accompanied by a subtle meaty note on the finish. The palate is well balanced with a nice concentration and rich acidity. The tannins are firm and fresh, leading to a long, mineral finish.
