# ViBo Vinedo Centenario Viu Manent

#### Wine description

This is a wine that speaks of Viu Manent's history, origins, and tradition in Colchagua. The grapes come from vineyards older than 100 years old at Viu Manent's Fundo San Carlos de Cunaco in the Colchagua Valley. The blend is 65% Cabernet Sauvignon and 35% Malbec.

### **Tasting note**

Intense ruby red with a violet hue. The nose is elegant, fresh, and intense with aromas of black currants, sour cherries, and fresh plums accompanied by a subtle herbal note. The palate is complex, with a long and mineral finish.
